

## VDP.ERSTE LAGE NUSSBIEN RIESLING

Nussbien is the southern neighbor of the Reiterpfad in Ruppertsberg and extends up to the edge of the Palatinate Forest. The wine presents itself very fresh but savory and salty with juniper, black pepper, some green apple and a hint of fresh cucumber. The palate is fresh, dense, salty, long, spicy and firm. Juniper, a slight etherealness and the juicy freshness are reminiscent of a walk through the woods in late summer.
